- 1. Use of Electricity by the Community
- 2. Use of Fuel in Residential and Commercial Stationary Combustion Equipment
- 3. On-road passenger and freight motor vehicle travel
- 4. Use of energy in potable and wastewater treatment and delivery systems
- 5. Generation of solid waste by community








Strongly Encouraged Frameworks

- 3. Household consumption





Additional Frameworks > Full consumption-based Inventory
